NIAGARA'S FURY

This 4D simulation offers an immersive experience that teaches you about the history of Niagara Falls. It's often described as the "perfect introduction" to your Niagara Falls adventure.



JOURNEY THROUGH THE FALLS

WHIRLPOOL AERO CAR

A scenic and exciting ride that take you over the Niagara Gorge. The car itself is an open-air car that allows you to have a panoramic view of the gorge during the ride.

The Niagara Cruises are the perfect opportunity to get as close as possible to the falls. With this activity, prepare to get misted and feel the force of the falls as you sail through the water.



WHITE WATER WALK

BUTTERFLY CONSERVATORY

The conservatory is located in the Botanical Gardens, and is home to over 2000 coloured butterflies. You can enjoy a self-guided walking tour through the glass-enclosed building with lush greenery and soothing waterfalls.
